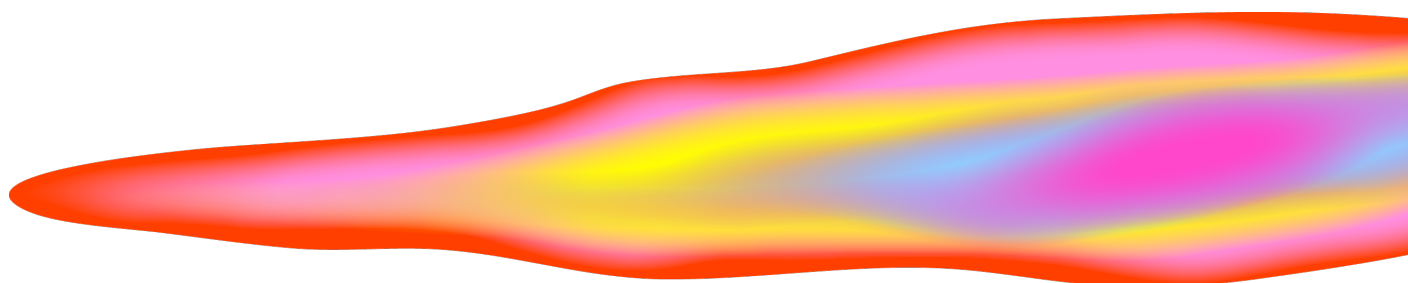

Despite the absence of a Grand Central, which makes us sad, Antigél is bouncing back by investing even more in Geneva and its nocturnal nooks and crannies. In fact, as we announced last December, there will be no Grand Central this year, despite the risks taken to make this project a reality, entirely self-financed by the bar and ticketing and sponsorship revenues. ANTIGEL X MOTEL CAMPO CLUBBING

Following the success of last year's evenings at Motel Campo, the collaboration continues with 8 evenings and a very special afternoon. Once again, Antigél and the Motel have joined forces to bring you a program with a strong Antigél DNA. This year, we've spiced things up with an extra touch of Antigél and SHAP SHAP. Local DJs, as always, but also an audacious program featuring international DJs, a multi-disciplinary spirit that Antigél has the secret of, with dance and a performative spirit very much in evidence, will be the hallmarks of these events. As last year, this temple of Geneva nightlife will exceptionally open its doors on Fridays AND Saturdays for the duration of the festival.

Highlights include a daytime Kiki ball, the LGBTQI community's iconic competition in which competitors face off against their rival Houses for glory! Breathtaking dance performances, an opportunity to get together around a theme and have fun through dance and stage expression, in the presence of artists from the voguing scene. Warm up the voice and stretch the legs! Another treat is the collaboration between Ozadya, a Geneva-based collective that has historically brought new baile sounds to our local scene, and London-based DJ of Mexican origin Manuka Honey, who has taken over clubs around the world with her distinctive live shows, reimagining the sounds of the Latin American diaspora, including dembow, baile funk and reggaeton. An evening that promises a wild atmosphere. Thanks to the actions of SHAP SHAP, the Motel will also be hosting a Ghana, What's Up? evening featuring the Zagaza collective and Ghanaian artists DJ MJ, Iveth Stunner, The Masked DJ, MC Diamond and Emma Korantema, who will be in residence in Switzerland during the festival. And last but not least, the Maraboutage family from Marseilles will be at Antigél in February, bringing their magical recipe for bewitching dancefloors for a night of fire! A multi-disciplinary and inclusive artistic energy, with music, dance and excess of all kinds.

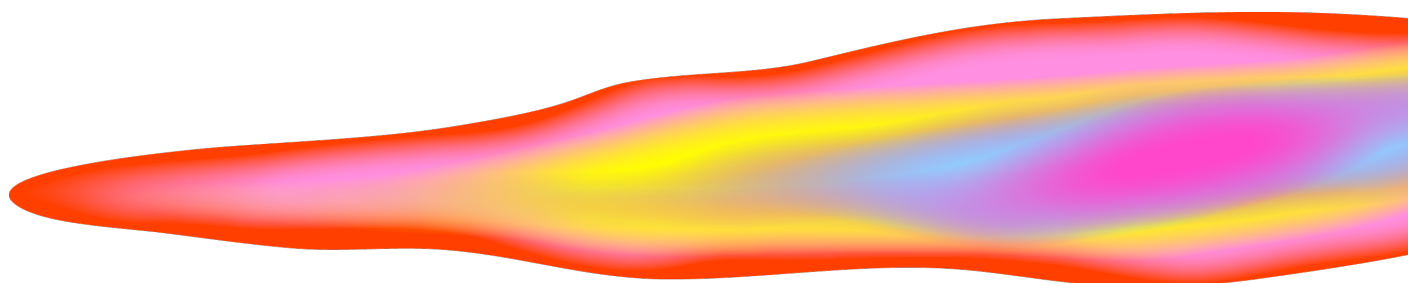
